The following day Greensboro manager Bobby Rice announces that Finch (left) has been released for make room for recently-acquired shortstop Justin Stein. Finch is hitting .216 with four doubles, one triple and a home run in 15 games since be-

ing acquired on May 24. Stein goes 2-for-5 in his Patriots' debut in a 7-2 win over the Norfolk Stars. Following his playing days, Finch, a two-sport star in football and baseball at Guilford, is employed for 42 years by Thomasville Furniture.
