PEACHES GET 26 RUNS, 31 HITS AND 16 STOLEN BASES; BABIES SCORE 4 ON 10 HITS

With every player in the lineup collecting at least two hits and scoring in every inning but the third, the Macon Peaches set South Atlantic (C) League single-game records with 26 runs, 31 hits and 16 stolen bases (including three of home) in a 26-4 victory over the visiting Albany Babies at Central City Park in Macon.

With the win, Macon snaps a four-game losing streak, improves to 18-17 and moves to within five games of front-running Savannah (22-11).

Albany drops to 13-22 and remains an even 10 games out. The Babies do gain a measure of revenge winning the next two games with the Peaches, 8-3 and 11-3.

Albany's Dana Fillingim, recently signed off of Cordele's South Georgia amateur championship team, makes his professional baseball debut and is driven from the box in the fifth inning, having allowed 15 runs on 17 hits and three walks.
